Rochelle Vaughn, a thirty six year old female with a kind heart and giving spirit, is known for her kindness and generosity to others. Now, Rochelle faces the biggest challenge of her young life. She was diagnosed with lymphoma cancer in April 2009 and she's determined to beat it!

Despite the diagnosis and the current treatment regimen, Rochelle's spirits are high. Prior to Rochelle's illness, she was a full time student on an academic scholarship at Cincinnati State College. She recently completed a ten month study abroad at the Nanjing Normal University in Nanjing, China. In her spirit of giving, while in Nanjing studying International Trade and Business Finance, Rochelle found the time to teach Chinese students the English language. Said a friend, "Rochelle is a blessing!"

Now, others are showing Rochelle their giving spirit and are demonstrating their commitment and appreciation for the generosity she shows others. The support and inspiration from family, friends, neighbors, and the community is evident as they come together to "**Rally for Rochelle**". Family and friends have formed "*The Rally for Rochelle – We Love You*" team and are eagerly raising needed funds for Rochelle's continued, innovative treatments which is not covered by traditional health insurances.

Rochelle has been receiving hyperbaric oxygen and intravenous therapies three times a week through The Cole Center for Healing. Her family has paid for these expenses out of pocket since April 2009. The treating physician, Dr. Theodore Cole reports

that Rochelle is responding favorable to this form of treatment. This holistic approach - not covered by traditional health insurances - cost \$850.00 per week. The family needs financial assistance to cover approximately 10 weeks of additional therapies.

To help raise needed funds, *Rally for Rochelle* is hosting a fundraiser on Sunday, August 30, 2009 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Rhino's Live, 11473 Chester Rd., Sharonville, Ohio. "Special" a live rhythm and blues band will be performing. The cost of admission is \$5.00/person (includes food). A silent auction will be held with outstanding items to bid on. In addition, participants can purchase raffle tickets with great prizes every 20 minutes. All proceeds will go directly towards Rochelle's care at the Cole Center for Healing.
